STATEMENT

Radio Corporation of America, a corporation duly organized under the laws of the State of Delaware, located in the city of New York, State of New York, and doing business at 30 Rockefeller Plaza, New York city, New York, has adopted and used the trade-mark shown in the accompanying drawing, for TELEVISION SETS; TELEVISION AND RADIO RECEIVER SET COMBINATIONS; AND TELEVISION-RADIO RECEIVER - RECORD PLAYER COMBINATIONS, in Class 21, Electrical apparatus, machines, and supplies, and presents herewith five specimens showing the trade-mark as actually used in connection with such goods, the trade-

mark being applied to cartons containing the goods and to the chassis, and requests that the same be registered in the United States Patent Office on the Principal Register in accordance with the act of July 5, 1946.

The trade-mark was first used in 1939, and first used in commerce among the several States which may lawfully be regulated by Congress in 1939. Applicant is the owner of T. M. Reg. 195,475 registered February 24, 1925 (renewed).
